


The Lutheran Church believes the church is always reforming.



What does it mean to be church?


Is church a place? A people? A denomination? A faith community?

is the event that brings about the salvation of the world and establishes the mission of the church.




What does it mean to be church?

The church is called to be witnesses


who carry, translate, communicate, and demonstrate the good news of God's love in Christ to the ends of the earth.





What is the role of pastors? How are decisions made? Where will we gather? Will we have a building? How will we engage our neighbors?




How does the church organize what it does?





View of Church

- The nature of church provides the basis for understanding the ministry of the church (to be).
- The ministry of the church provides the framework for understanding the organization of the church (to do).
- The organization of the church provides the structures for the church to carry out its ministry (organize what it does).
